If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the Compulsory Competition Class/es will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules - Chapter 1, Rule 9. Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.

4.	There Will be timed qualifying at this event.	
5.	FORMAT 1 – TIMED QUALIFYING EVENT	
5.1.	Qualifying	One Qualifying Session of 6 minutes. PLEASE NOTE: Grid position for qualifying will be in order of entry through CMS. ie 1 st entry = P1 on grid for qualifying, 2 nd entry = P2 on grid for qualifying etc
5.2.	Heats	There will be 2 Heats. The Grid for Heat 1 will be set from times achieved in Qualifying, with the fastest time on grid 1, and so on.
5.3.	Pre-finals	1 Pre-final The grid positions for the Pre-Final 1 will replicate the finishing order of Heat 1. The grid positions for Pre-Final 2 will be from the points tally from Heat 1 and Pre-Final 1 with the highest points to Grid 1 and so on.
5.4.	Final	1 Final The grid for the Final will be set from the points tally with the highest points from Heat 1, Pre-Final 1 and Pre-Final 2 to grid 1 and so on. The driver with the highest points tally of the day is the winner of the day (All Points Count).
