4.2.	Heats	There will be 2 Heats. The Grid for Heat 1 will be set from times achieved in Qualifying, with fastest time on grid 1, and so on.
4.3.		The Grid for Heat 2 will be set from the results of Qualifying in reverse order, with the slowest on Pole Position etc.
4.4.	Pre-finals	There will be 2 Pre-Finals. 1 Pre-final The grid for the Pre-final 1 will be set from accumulated points of Heat 1, Heat 2 and Heat 3, with the lowest points starting on Pole Position.
		2 Pre-final The Grid for Pre-final 2 will be set from accumulated points of Heat 1, Heat 2 and Pre-final 1 with the lowest points starting on Pole Position.

4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
