3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit crew with trolleys will not be given access to the circuit during qualifying and racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit crew must only enter the circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshals and then only if wearing a high visibility safety vest on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the in or out grids at the Grid Marshalls' direction.
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of fuel or tyres. Please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
4.4.	No scooters, mini bikes, roller blades, skateboards, tricycles, etc allowed at the complex during the entire meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	Clear visors will be used at the direction of stewards.
