4.1.	Qualifying	One Qualifying Session of 6 minutes
4.2.	Heats	There will be 1 Heat The Grid for Heat 1 will be set from times achieved in qualifying, with fastest time on Grid 1, and so on.
4.3.	Pre-finals	Pre-Final 1 The grid for Pre-Final 1 will replicate the finishing order of Heat 1 Pre-Final 2 The grid for Pre-Final 2 will be set using the Zero Point System with the lowest

		points from Heat 1 and Pre-Final 1 to grid 1 and so on.				
4.4.	Top 5 Shoot Out	<p>**FEATURE CLASSES ONLY**</p> <p>The top 5 placed drivers after Heat & Pre-finals 1 & 2 will contest a timed “Hot-Lap” to finalise Top 5 grid placings. Fastest in Hot Lap will be grid 1, 2nd Fastest grid 2 and so on to Grid 5. Hot lap will be one warm up lap and one timed lap. This will take place in order 5th down to 1st, with 1st being the last competitor.</p>				
4.5.	Final	<p>1 Final. The grid for the Final will be set from the points tally from Heat 1, Pre-Final 1 & Pre-Final 2 with the lowest points to Grid 1, second lowest to grid 2 and so on.</p> <p>***FEATURE CLASSES ONLY***</p> <p>1 Final. The grid for the Final from Grid position 6 and onward will be set from the points tally from Heat 1, Pre-Final 1 & Pre-Final 2 with the 6th lowest points to grid 6, seventh lowest to grid 7 and so on. 3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via grids as directed by officials.
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	Clear visors to be used as/when directed by officials.
4.7.	Camping is allowed. Please bring own generator. Showers available. Track will be open from Thursday 28/10/16 for those camping.
