4.2.	Pre-Final	The Grid for Pre-Final 1 will replicate the finishing order of Heat 1.		
4.3.	Final	1 Final. The grid for the Final will be set using the points tally from Heat 1 and Pre-Final 1 with the highest points to grid 1, second highest to grid 2 and so on. Winner of the Event will be the driver with the highest points tally from Heat 1, Pre-Final 1 and Final (all points count)

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts will be retrieved via TKC trolley persons
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	Our Liquor License prohibits BYO alcohol.
4.7.	All P Platers must be scrutineered by an Official.
4.8.	Clear Visors must be used when directed by Officials.

SPECIAL NOTES

- This is designed to be a **FUN** meeting, but we still must comply with KA regulations.
- Final ONLY will be Manually scored, due to 540m track configuration not crossing the Start/Finish line.
- Transponders compulsory (just like a normal race meeting)
- People wishing to "Have a Go" in a friends or relatives kart, must sign an insurance indemnity form and comply with ALL KA regulations regarding this.
 - **Cadet age children can only use karts with MiniRok or Comer engines.**
 - **Junior age children can only use karts with Restricted KA100 or Yamaha J engines.**
 - **Seniors can only use karts with Yamaha J or Restricted KA100 engines , Yamaha S engines or RESTRICTED 125 engines.**
 - **All Have A Go drivers must be wearing a minimum of long pants (jeans), long sleeves, gloves and enclosed shoes. Race suits are recommended, but not compulsory.**
- Drivers are not permitted on track to practice until they have completed driver registration and scrutineering.
- CHECK YOUR HELMET: DOES IT CONFORM TO CURRENT RULES? (i.e. is it less than 10 years old?)
- Restrictors (**Cadets / Restricted 125**) may be sealed. Must have nuts fitted on exhaust.
- OPEN CLASS: Shifter, Reed, Rotary, Piston Port, Single or twin, whatever you've got in the shed. Bring it down and give it a run. Tyres open.
