If time permits Albany City Kart Club may allow a Come and Try session at the end of racing:

People wishing to "Have a Go" in a friends or relatives kart, must sign an insurance indemnity form and comply with ALL KA regulations regarding this.

- Cadet age children can only use karts with MiniRok or Comer engines.
- Junior age children can only use karts with Restricted KA100 or Yamaha J engines.
- Seniors can only use karts with Yamaha J or Restricted KA100 engines, Yamaha S engines or
- RESTRICTED 125 engines.
- All Have A Go drivers must be wearing a minimum of long pants (jeans), long sleeves, gloves and
- enclosed shoes. Race suits are recommended, but not compulsory.

Come and Try session will be supervised by the clubs KA Officials.
