If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the Compulsory Competition Classes will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules - Chapter 1, Rule 9. Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.

2.	Practice	Practice sessions will be held Friday & Saturday as per timetable NOTE: COMPATIBLE CLASSES WILL BE COMBINED FOR UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE IF NECESSARY
3.	Qualifying	There will be Timed Qualifying at this Event if there are more than sixteen (16) competitors in the class.
		There will be one (1) standalone Qualifying session of 6 minutes The order of Karts on the grid for the commencement of Qualifying must be random – no high/low numbers)
4.	Heats & Final	If there are more than sixteen (16) Competitors in the Class or Division the following will take place: (1) One (1) Qualifying: Minimum of six (6) minutes duration for each Class (2) Heat 1: Grid Positions in accordance with the results of Qualifying, with the fastest Driver on Pole Position and so on (3) Heat 2: Grid Positions in accordance with the results of Heat 1, with the winner on Pole Position and so on.

		<p>(4) Heat 3: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1 and Heat 2 will start on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>(5) Heat 4: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2 and Heat 3 will start on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>(6) Final: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2, Heat 3 and Heat 4 will start on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>(7) P platers in Cadet 9 and 12 Classes will be placed rear of field for entire Meeting.</p> <p>If there are less than sixteen (16) Competitors in the Class or Division the following will take place For the avoidance of doubt this includes when a Class or Division is consolidated in accordance with the Rules:</p> <p>(8) Heat 1: Grid Positions will be determined by Random Draw</p> <p>(9) Heat 2: Grid Positions will be determined by Reverse Random Draw i.e: Inverse positions from Heat 1.</p> <p>(10) Heat 3: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1 and Heat 2 will start on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>(11) Heat 4: Lowest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2 and Heat 3 will start on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>(12) Final: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2, Heat 3 and Heat 4 will start on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>P platers in each Class or Division will be placed at rear of field for the entire Meeting.</p>

3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.	
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via grids as directed by officials	
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS	
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.	
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.	
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.	
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
