<b>4.</b>	Heats & Final	<p>If there are more than sixteen (16) Competitors in the Class or Division the following will take place:</p> <p>(1) One (1) Qualifying: Minimum of six (6) minutes duration for each Class</p> <p>(2) Heat 1: Grid Positions in accordance with the results of Qualifying, with the fastest Driver on Pole Position and so on</p> <p>(3) Heat 2: Grid Positions in accordance with the results of Heat 1, with the winner on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>(4) Heat 3: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1 and Heat 2 will start on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>(5) Heat 4: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2 and Heat 3 will start on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>(6) Final: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2, Heat 3 and Heat 4 will start on Pole Position and so on.</p> <p>(7) P platers in Cadet 9 and 12 Classes will be placed rear of field for entire Meeting.</p> <p>If there are less than sixteen (16) Competitors in the Class or Division the following will take place</p>

<b>3.1.</b>	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
<b>3.2.</b>	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
<b>3.3.</b>	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
<b>4.</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
<b>4.1.</b>	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
<b>4.2.</b>	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
<b>4.3.</b>	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
<b>4.4.</b>	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
