1.3	Heats & Final	If there are more than sixteen (16) Competitors in the Class or Division the following will take place: (1) One (1) Qualifying: Minimum of six (6) minutes duration for each class (2) Heat 1: Grid Positions in accordance with the results of Qualifying, with the Fastest Driver on Pole Position and so on. (3) Heat 2: Grid Positions in accordance with the results of Heat 1, with the winner on Pole Position and so on. (4) Heat 3: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1 and Heat 2 will start on Pole Position and so
