Trophies will be presented to the first 5 place-getters in all Classes. A trophy will also be presented to fastest Qualifier in each Class.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

KART RETRIEVAL:

Pit Crew with trolleys will NOT be given access to the Track during Qualifying and Racing. Retrieval is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Track when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a high visibility safety vest in accordance with the Rules.

Karts can be retrieved via access through the In/Out Grid only.

INSURANCE:

Has been effected for this Meeting in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 3 of the 2019 KA Manual.

SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering for this Meeting will be in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the KA Manual.

• Licence cards MUST be presented with scrutineering forms and Tyre collection.

In accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2019 KA Manual, each Kart shall have affixed to it a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark supplied for the Meeting. This signifies that the Driver has confirmed their entry for the Meeting and completed a Scrutineering Form relevant to the Entry.

As from 1.15pm Saturday 28/09/2019, the Grid Marshal / Scrutineers shall not allow any Kart that does not display a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark to Practice, Qualify or Race. Failure to comply will result in the Driver being excluded from the Meeting.

FRONT FAIRING (Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 g) (iii):

The Front Fairing Fitment Rules Will Not be used at this Meeting.

FORWARD FACING VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEM (Technical Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 8 i)(iv):

The Forward-Facing Video Recording System Rules Will be used at this Meeting.

Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures -

- a) A separate SD Card must be used for each Class or Division Contested at the Event.
- b) Prior to the commencement of on-track activity on each day of Competition, the SD Card used in the camera fitted to a kart must be completely cleared and reformatted.
- c) No recorded vision on the SD Card may be deleted from the time that on-track activity has commenced on each day of Competition until 0700 hours the day following Competition ending, without prior written permission from the Stewards.

ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING:

Each engine and Chassis must be sealed and tagged in accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6. The use of a single chassis and engine for more than one Class is allowable for this Event provided there are separate seals for each Class.

TRANSPONDER FITTING INSTRUCTIONS:

MYLAPS compatible transponders must be mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 i)

Note: All Karts MUST have fitted and correctly charged and operating transponders for the Timed Practice session commencing 1.15pm 28/09/2019.

TIMING AND LAP SCORING RECORDING:

Will be conducted in accordance with Competition Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 j).

TYRE POOLING (Tech, Chap 4 Rule 5):

Tyre Pooling WILL occur at this meeting. Tyres will be available at the designated times as laid out in the timetable. It is the drivers responsibility to collect his/her tyres between the stated times.

NB - All Competitors are to supply their own Wet Weather Tyres and must present them for marking scanning to the nominated area when directed. WA Open Performance Drivers must supply their own 5th Dry Tyre should it be required which must be presented to the Chief Scrutineer prior to replacement.

VEHICLE / TRAILER ACCESS:

Vehicles will be allowed in Pit Area Friday 27th September for the purpose of set up of Pit Space. <u>ABSOLUTELY NO VEHICLES</u> will be allowed to remain in Pit area after 7.30am Saturday 28th September. Any vehicle not moved will be at risk of being towed at owner's expense. <u>NO TIMED PRACTICE OR RACING WILL COMMENCE</u> until <u>ALL</u> vehicles are removed from Pit Area.

SECURITY:

No Security will be provided for the duration of the event.

PIT ALLOCATION:

Sponsors will be given a free 3m x 3m Premium Pit Space. If required, on additional 3mx3m space will be available for \$50. Remaining Premium 3mx3m pit spaces will be available for \$50 each (maximum 2) You will need to apply for these. They will be allocated on a first come, first served basis by the club, after entries close. NO GUARANTEES. **Drivers who require wheelchair access, please email esperancekartklub@gmail.com

Appendix 1

WA Open Performance Class

1) PREAMBLE

The WA Open Performance Class was conceived to be a high performance Class for Western Australian conditions. It is to be read in conjunction with the Open Performance Class, Class Rules - Chapter 17 of the KA Manual.

Karting WA created the Class allowing a range of engine categories, with each category having a weight which has been selected with the goal of creating a similar overall performance for each engine category over a range of circuits.

For the avoidance of doubt, at a Club Competition KA1, DD2 and KZ2 must be permitted to compete in accordance with their respective Class Rules, including the specified weights and tyres.

It is permitted to change engine category and corresponding weight during a race day, however the Stewards must be advised of any such change prior to the next on Track activity.

In keeping with the very basic philosophy, and ensuring Class requires the minimum of regulations and engine measuring, a Kart will be eligible if the Kart:

- a) Complies with the Rules and these Regulations; and
- b) The engine is within the capacity limits as specified for it(s) engine category as outlined below.

2) LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

a) A Driver must hold a Minimum of a Senior B Grade licence.

3) DRIVETRAIN

- a) Engine
 - i) Major engine components (crankshaft, crankcases, cylinder barrel and externals of cylinder head) must be derived from AKA or CIK registered engines.
 - ii) Two Stroke or Four Stroke engines.
 - iii) Single or Twin engines.
 - iv) Engines may be air or water cooled.
 - v) Supercharging is not permitted.
 - vi) Additional restrictions for specific events may be specified in the event's Supplementary Regulations.
- b) Carburettor
 - i) One (1) carburettor per cylinder is permitted to be fitted to an engine.
- c) Ignition
 - i) Electric starters are permitted.
- d) Clutch
 - i) Clutches are permitted.
- e) Ignition
 - i) Digital ignitions systems are permitted if fitted to the engine originally by the manufacturer and are of the same type and style as originally fitted, otherwise.
 - ii) Only analogue type ignition systems are permitted.
- f) Brakes
 - i) Front wheel brakes may be used.
 - ii) Front wheel brakes are compulsory on all Karts with a combined (Kart and Driver) weight of above 170kg.
- g) Fuel
 - i) The only fuel permitted to be used is Pump Fuel Premium Unleaded (PULP).

4) TYRES

- a) Dry Weather Tyres in accordance with Class Rules Chapter 17 Rule 7a.
- b) Wet Weather Tyres in accordance with Class Rules Chapter 17 Rule 7b.
- c) A Maximum of five (5) Dry Weather Tyres may be used at a Meeting.
- d) A Maximum of five (5) Wet Weather Tyres may be used at a Meeting.
- e) The Tyre replacement provisions in the Rules do not apply.
- f) Bead retention is:
 - i) compulsory on all Karts with a combined (Kart and Driver) weight of above 170kg; and
 - ii) optional for all other weights.

5) ENGINE CAPACITY & WEIGHT

a) The table below outlines the Maximum engine capacity and the Minimum weight including the Driver for each type of eligible engine:
