3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH</b>
3.3.	VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the In Grid or Out Grid at the conclusion of that race.
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.

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4.2.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.3.	No scooters (motorised or otherwise), drones, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles, or any other motorised/remote controlled devices allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.4.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.5.	Engines and Restrictors will be sealed for this meeting.
4.6.	Clear visors may be necessary to be used under advice from Officials.
4.7.	Bar Coding/marking of tyres will occur at this meeting.
4.8.	Video Recording System required at this race meeting, as per State Regulations.
4.9.	TYRES: Competitors in the TaG 125 Light and TaG 125 Heavy classes MUST ONLY USE MG FZ Prime (Yellow) Dry Tyres with barcoded serial numbers beginning with 104 or higher.
