4.2 Payment of the Entry Fee can be made as follows:

Payment at the Track Will be accepted for entries received on the day. EFT also available at the track.
<b>5. MINIMUM ENTRIES</b>
5.1 4 is the minimum number of pre-entries which must be received for each Competition Group.
5.2 If insufficient entries are received for a Competition Group to form in its own right, the Competition Group <u>must be</u> consolidated in accordance with the Competition Rules Chapter 1 – Rule 9.
<b>6. COME &amp; TRY SESSION</b>
6.1 “COME AND TRY” sessions Will be conducted at this Meeting.
<b>7. TEAMS COMPETITION – 4SS SENIOR ENDURO</b>
7.1 Teams Competition Will be conducted at this Meeting.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Minimum 2 Drivers, Maximum 4 Drivers per Team.</li> <li>b) Only ONE driver from each team needs to Pre-Enter via CMS, paying the full \$50 Entry Fee (regardless of racing in any other Class on the day). All Team Drivers must complete a Scrutineering Record on the day and Register as a team at Driver Registration.</li> <li>c) For each ‘A’ or ‘B’ Grade Licence holder on a Team, there must a ‘C’ or ‘D’ Grade Licence holder on the same Team.</li> <li>d) No refuelling of karts permitted.</li> <li>e) No tyre changes permitted (except for replacement tyre approved by Chief Scrutineer/Chief Steward, for reasons due to defect or otherwise considered unsafe).</li> <li>f) Chain lube permitted ONLY in designated concrete area within In Grid, while the kart is safely on a trolley.</li> <li>g) Set up changes are permitted within the designated area of the In Grid, while the kart is on a trolley.</li> <li>h) Minimum of three (3) Pit Stops per team (2 x stints maximum per driver, double stinting allowed - you must still complete all 3 pit stops)</li> <li>i) All Pit Stops will be three (3) Minutes minimum, timed by Judge(s) of Fact. Leaving the Out Grid before your 3 minutes is up, will incur a penalty.</li> <li>j) Each individual Driver may not complete more than 60% of total laps/time for their team. Team’s which have any driver complete more than 60% of racing, will incur a penalty.</li> <li>k) Failing to complete Minimum of 3 Pit Stops per team, will incur a penalty.</li> <li>l) Excessive speed on the In Grid or Out Grid will incur a penalty</li> <li>m) Dangerous Pit Entry will incur a penalty</li> <li>n) All kart must be on a trolley and walked safely from In Grid to Out Grid for all Pit Stops</li> <li>o) All teams will be weighed prior to the event to establish a Total Team Weight. Total Team Weight is the weight of the kart plus the average driver weight for each Team. Eg. All Drivers on each Team will be weighed wearing all Safety Apparel, the total of all Drivers weight will be divided by 2 (for 2 Driver Teams),</li> </ul>

divided by 3 (for 3 Driver Teams), or divided by 4 (for 4 Driver Teams).

<b>3.</b>	<b>KART RETRIEVAL</b>
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will Not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via In Grid or Out Grid at the completion of that race.
<b>4.</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
4.1.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.2.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.3.	No remote control cars, motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.4.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
