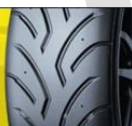

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the In Grid or the Out Grid – please exit via the Ambulance gate if closer & not during Qualifying.
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No remote control vehicles of any kind including drones, motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, pushbikes and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.

	<p>Series to have a video recording system that is mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 8 i) (iv) and be fully operational at all times while the kart is on the track.</p> <p>ii) The date & time on the camera must be set to the time zone of the Meeting.</p> <p>e) Video Recording System – Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures</p> <p>i) A separate SD card must be used for each Class or Division contested at the Meeting.</p> <p>ii) Prior to the commencement of the on-track activity on each day of Competition, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a kart must be completely cleared and formatted.</p> <p>iii) No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that the on-track activity has commenced on each day of the Meeting until one (1) hour after the completion of the following Event, without the prior written permission of the Stewards.</p>
4.7.	<p>Smoking</p> <p>i) Midwest Kart Club paddock is designated as a public area at a Meeting. As such it is a NO SMOKING AREA.</p> <p>ii) Smoking in the paddock is strictly prohibited.</p>
