ADDENDUM No. 9

At the NKC Meeting held 5th and 6th March, 2010, the following was approved and is now applicable.

1. Addition to preamble in chapter 13

Chapter 13 – COMPETITION DRIVER LICENCES:

Amendment is as follows:

Preamble:

The Australian Karting Association issues, manages and records all AKA issued licences using the “AKA Licence System”.

The AKA currently issues licences as either;

- a) Non-competition licences (Social Practice Only Licence) Refer to rule 13.15.1
- b) Competition Licences. Refer to rule 13.15.2, 3, 4, and 5
- c) Single Event Competition Licences. Refer to rule 13.16.
- d) CIK International Licences. Refer to rule 13.20

In order to qualify as a competitor or as a driver, any person must, except as herein after provided, be the holder of either a licence issued on the authority of the AKA or a licence recognised by the AKA.

All AKA licence holders MUST purchase a current AKA Manual.

Notwithstanding anything in these rules the AKA/SKC may, in writing, waive the necessity for competitors or drivers to hold a licence under these Rules in order to be eligible to take part in a particular competition.

The AKA may also grant a general waiver in respect of competitors or drivers in Closed Competitions (other than race meetings) subject to such conditions as it may from time to time announce.
