

2007 STATE RULES RELATING TO WESTERN AUSTRALIAN STATE TITLE SERIES

1. "Western Australian State Title" class champions will be allocated red plates (to be supplied by AKA(WA)) with white numbers bearing number 1. The plates are to be used only in the class they were awarded (1ST PLACE ONLY).
2. For a CLASS to be eligible for final series points the CLASS must have a minimum of four (4) entries to constitute a class.
3. For a COMPETITOR to be eligible for final series points the COMPETITOR must nominate and compete in all available meetings.
4. All points scored will count towards the final points tally for each driver.
5. CLASSES that have not ran at the first round and are therefore ineligible for the series do not need to be offered over the remaining rounds. The host club may choose to offer the class as a support class.
6. **CLASSES:**
 - Midget
 - Rookie
 - Junior National Light
 - Junior National Heavy
 - Junior Clubman
 - Senior National Combined (150kg)
 - Sportsman 100 Light
 - Sportsman 100 Heavy
 - Sportsman 100 Super Heavy
(Heavy and Super Heavy maximum kart weights: air cooled 88kgs, water cooled 93kgs)
 - Sportsman 125 Light
 - Sportsman 125 Heavy
 - Over 40's
 - Open
7. **FORMAT:** 289 Point System
 - 5 Heats - Ballot
 - Reverse Ballot
 - Highest to Front
 - Highest to Rear
 - Highest to Front
8. Individual clubs to adjust laps to accommodate classes on the day.

9. Closing date for entries: 7 days from event. Late entries will be accepted up to date of event on subscribed classes only and will be rear of field for first two (2) heats.
10. **ENTRY FEE** (*all fees inclusive of GST (where applicable) and National and State Track Development Levies*)
Senior - \$50.00
Junior/Rookie/Midget - \$30.00
(*For all classes, if person is racing more than one class, second or subsequent entry fee will be \$15.00.*)
11. AKA(WA) to maintain points scores for Western Australian State Title Series.

1st - Perpetual, Red Plate, patch.
2nd - Patch.
