

2010 STATE RULES RELATING TO **SOUTH EASTERN ZONE SERIES**

1. WA "Zone Series" class champions will be allocated black plates (to be supplied by AKA(WA)) with yellow numbers bearing their own State number. The plates are to be used only in the class they were awarded (1ST PLACE ONLY) and only within Western Australia.
2. For a CLASS to be eligible for final series points the CLASS must have a minimum of four (4) entries to constitute a class.
3. For a COMPETITOR to be eligible for final series points the COMPETITOR must nominate and compete in all available meetings.
4. All points scored will count towards the final point tally for each driver where a class has four (4) entries.
5. **CLASSES**
 - *Midget (90kg)*
(If the 4 clubs have less than 4 licensed drivers, rounds to be run with drivers nominated (even if not 4) and be eligible for final series points and awards)
 - *Rookie (105kg)*
(If the 4 clubs have less than 4 licensed drivers, rounds to be run with drivers nominated (even if not 4) and be eligible for final series points and awards)
 - *Junior National Light (120kgs)*
 - *Junior National Heavy (140kgs)*
(If there are not enough numbers in Junior National Light and Junior National Heavy run combined at a weight of 130kg)
 - *Junior Performance*
(If the 4 clubs have less than 4 licensed drivers, rounds to be run with drivers nominated (even if not 4) and be eligible for final series points and awards)
 - *Senior National Combined (145kgs)*
 - *Sportsman 100 Light (140kg)*
 - *Sportsman 100 Heavy (160kg)*
 - *Sportsman 100 Super Heavy (180kg)*
(Heavy and Super Heavy maximum kart weights air cooled 88kgs, water cooled 93kgs.)
 - *Over 40's*
 - *Sportsman 125 Light (150kg)*
 - *Sportsman 125 Heavy (175kg)*
 - *Sportsman 125 Super Heavy (200kg)*
 - *Restricted 125 Combined (170kg)*

6. **FORMAT**

289 Points System

5 heats :

- Ballot
- Reverse ballot
- Highest to front
- Highest to rear
- Highest to front

7. A race distance of approximately 8 kilometres for each heat. The promoter reserves the right to change the distance.
8. Closing date for entries: 7 days from event. Late entries will be accepted up to last post on the Friday prior to the event on subscribed classes only and will be put rear of field for first two (2) heats. **No entries will be accepted on the day of competition.**
9. **ENTRY FEE** (all fees inclusive of GST (where applicable) and National and State Track Development Levies).
Senior - \$50.00. Second class \$25.00.
Junior/Rookie/Midget - \$30.00. Second class \$15.00.
10. AKA(WA) to maintain points scores for South Eastern Zone Series.
11. **AWARDS** (To be supplied by AKA(WA))
1st - Black Plate and patch.
2nd - Patch.
3rd - Patch.
12. **ZONE ROUND AWARDS** (to be supplied by the Club)
Trophies or prizes to be presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class. A participation award to be presented to all Midget, Rookie and Junior national Drivers who compete, but do not place at each zone round.
