






4. CIRCUIT SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

2.	MEDICAL SERVICES

3.	KART RETRIEVAL						
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.						
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course						
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.						
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via in or out grid.						
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS						
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.)					
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.						
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.						
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.						
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.						
4.6.	Front Fairing (Drop Down Bumpers) will be in use for ALL classes at this race meeting, as per State Regulations. The following conditions apply to the fitment of the Front Faring (Nose Cone) a. The use of the CIK-FIA homologated front fairing mounting kit (the "Mounting Kit") of the bodywork homologation period 2015 – 2021 is mandatory. b. From the commencement of the first Heat until the conclusion of the Final, each Driver must enter the Grid area with the front fairing detached from their Kart. c. The Pit Crew member or the Driver themselves must mount the front fairing in the Out Grid area under supervision of a Scrutineer or an appointed Official. Front Fairing correct installation a. From the commencement of the first Heat onwards, the front fairing (using the Mounting Kit) must be in the correct position at all times during a Competition (see Appendix 1, Figure 8) It must not be modified or have been subjected to mechanical or chemical treatment (other than normal cleaning) in any way. b. If the Judge of Fact reports that the front fairing on one or more karts was no longer in the correct position when the "black and white chequered flag" was displayed and the Kart(s) concerned. c. This penalty is not susceptible to protest or appeal. d. Should a Driver be found/proved to have intentionally replaced or attempted to replace a front fairing which is not installed correctly during the Race or after the "black and white chequered flag" was displayed they will be Disqualified from the Meeting. 




	EXITING KART POST RACE ALL Drivers MUST REMAIN SEATED in their Kart upon entering the In Grid at the completion of a race until direction to exit their Kart is given by an Official. Any Driver who leaves their Kart before the instruction to exit their kart is given may receive a penalty. Recommended Minimum Penalty – two (2) places.
4.7.	If time permits Karratha Kart Club may allow a Come and Try session at the end of racing: People wishing to "Have a Go" in a friends or relatives kart, must sign an insurance indemnity form and comply with ALL KA regulations regarding this. Cadet age children can only use karts with MiniRok or Comer engines. Junior age children can only use karts with Restricted KA100 or Yamaha J engines. Seniors can only use karts with Yamaha J or Restricted KA100 engines, Yamaha S engines or RESTRICTED 125 engines. All Have A Go drivers must be wearing a minimum of long pants (jeans), long sleeves, gloves and enclosed shoes. Race suits are recommended, but not compulsory. Come and Try session will be supervised by the clubs KA Officials.

Appendix 1 - Front Fairing Installation

Your attention is drawn to the correct positioning of the Front Fairing.

If any part of the tubes of the front bumper are in the areas marked "A".
