1.	FORMAT OF RACING					
2.	Practice	2 Practice session/s of 5 minutes will be held.				
3.	Qualifying	There Will be Timed Qualifying at this Event only if there are more than twenty (20) competitors in the Class. There will be one (1) Qualifying session of 6 minutes The order of Karts on the grid for the commencement of Qualifying will be determined by order of entries received into CMS.				
4.	Heats & Final	a) Each Round of the Series will consist of, and be conducted in the following manner: i) If there are more than twenty (20) Competitors in a Class or Division the following will take place: 1. One (1) Qualifying: Minimum of six (6) minutes duration for each Class 2. Heat 1: Grid Positions in accordance with the results of Qualifying, with the fastest Driver on Pole Position and so on 3. Heat 2: Grid Positions in accordance with the results of Heat 1, with the winner on Pole Position and so on. 4. Heat 3: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1 and Heat 2 will start on Pole Position and so on. 5. Heat 4: Lowest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2 and Heat 3 will start on Pole Position and so on. 6. Final: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2, Heat 3 and Heat 4 will start on Pole Position and so on. 7. P platers in Cadet 9 and 12 Classes will be placed rear of field for entire Meeting. ii) If there twenty (20) or less Competitors in the Class or Division the following will take place. For the avoidance of doubt, this includes when a Class or Division is consolidated in accordance with the Rules: 1. Heat 1: Grid Positions will be determined by Random Draw 2. Heat 2: Grid Positions will be determined by Reverse Random Draw i.e: Inverse positions from Heat 1. 3. Heat 3: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1 and Heat 2 will start on Pole Position and so on. 4. Heat 4: Lowest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2, Heat 3 and Heat 4 will start on Pole Position and so on. 5. Final: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2, Heat 3 and Heat 4 will start on Pole Position and so on. 6. P platers in each Class or Division will be placed at rear of field for the entire Meeting. b) Heat 1 and Heat 2 will have an approximate race distance of 9km. The Final will have an approximate race distance of 9km.

3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.				
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course				
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.				
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via grids at the discretion of the officials.				
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS				
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.				
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.				
4.3.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.				
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.				
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.

4.6.	General Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 5 d)				
	If a Participant is unable to be present in person at the Competition, they must nominate a representative in				
	writing who is the holder of a valid Participant's Licence or is a person over the age of 18 years who is the holder				
	of a valid Driver's Licence. The person having charge of an entered kart during any part of a Meeting Competition				
	is responsible jointly and severally with the Participant for the respect of all the provisions of the Rules, the ISC,				
	the Technical Regulations, Championship Regulations, Series Regulations, Supplementary Regulations,				
	Addendums and Bulletins pertaining to that Meeting.				
4.7.	Video Recording System required at this race meeting, as per State Regulations.				
	Front Fairing (Drop Down Bumpers) will be in use for ALL classes at this race meeting, as per State Regulations.				
	The following conditions apply to the fitment of the Front Faring (Nose Cone)				
	a. The use of the CIK-FIA homologated front fairing mounting kit (the "Mounting Kit") of the bodywork				
	homologation period 2015 – 2021 is mandatory.				
	b. From the commencement of the first Heat until the conclusion of the Final, each Driver must enter the Out Grid area with the front fairing detached from their Kart.				
	c. The Pit Crew member or the Driver themselves must mount the front fairing in the Out Grid area under				
	the supervision of a Scrutineer or an appointed Official.				
	Front Fairing correct installation				
	a. From the commencement of the first Heat onwards, the front fairing (using the Mounting Kit)				
	must be in the correct position at all times during a Competition (see Appendix 1, Figure 8) It				
	must not be modified or have been subjected to mechanical or chemical treatment (other than normal cleaning) in any way.				
4.8.	b. If the Judge of Fact reports that the front fairing on one or more karts was no longer in the				
	correct position when the "black and white chequered flag" was displayed and the Kart(s)				
	concerned crossed the finish line, in all situations a penalty will be imposed automatically on				
	the driver(s) concerned.				
	c. This penalty is not susceptible to protest or appeal.				
	d. Should a Driver be found/proved to have intentionally replaced or attempted to replace a front fairing which is not installed correctly during the Race or after the "black and white chequered flag" was				
	displayed they will be Disqualified from the Meeting.				
	EXITING KART POST RACE				
	ALL Drivers MUST REMAIN SEATED in their Kart upon entering the In Grid at the completion of a race until direction				
	to exit their Kart is given by an Official. Any Driver who leaves their Kart before the instruction to exit their kart is given may receive a				
	penalty. Recommended Minimum Penalty – two (2) places.				
	Camping will be allowed on site – bring your own generators.








Appendix 1 - Front Fairing Installation
