

	 All Have A Go drivers must be wearing a minimum of long pants (jeans), long sleeves, gloves and 							
	 enclosed shoes. Race suits are recommended, but not compulsory. 							
	Come and Try session will be supervised by the clubs KA Officials.							
5.	TEMPORARY FACILITIES/STRUCTURES							
5.1	Your attention is drawn to General Rules Chapter 4 Rule 21 - Temporary Facilities/Structures Rules (the "TFS Rules")							
5.2	Type A Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules are permitted to be erected at this Meeting.							
	Type B Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules (i.e. with a floor plan between 18 sqm and 36sq) Will be permitted to be

	The Structure must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules.							
5.4	Unless specifically approved by the Organiser, Type C Structures Will Not be permitted to be erected at this Meeting.
