Seniors can only use karts with Yamaha J or Restricted KA100 engines, Yamaha S engines or  RESTRICTED 125 engines.  All Have A Go drivers must be wearing a minimum of long pants (jeans), long sleeves, gloves and enclosed shoes. Race suits are recommended, but not compulsory.  Come and Try session will be supervised by the clubs KA Officials.
