4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS					
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.					
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.					
4.3.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.					
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.					
4.5.	<ul> <li>If time permits Esperance Kart Klub may allow a Come and Try session at the end of racing:</li> <li>People wishing to "Have a Go" in a friends or relatives kart, must sign an insurance indemnity form and comply with ALL KA regulations regarding this.</li> <li>Cadet age children can only use karts with MiniRok or Comer engines.</li> <li>Junior age children can only use karts with Restricted KA100 or Yamaha J engines.</li> <li>Seniors can only use karts with Yamaha J or Restricted KA100 engines , Yamaha S engines or</li> <li>RESTRICTED 125 engines.</li> <li>All Have a Go drivers must be wearing a minimum of long pants (jeans), long sleeves, gloves and</li> <li>enclosed shoes. Race suits are recommended, but not compulsory.</li> <li>Come and Try session will be supervised by the clubs KA Officials.</li> </ul>
